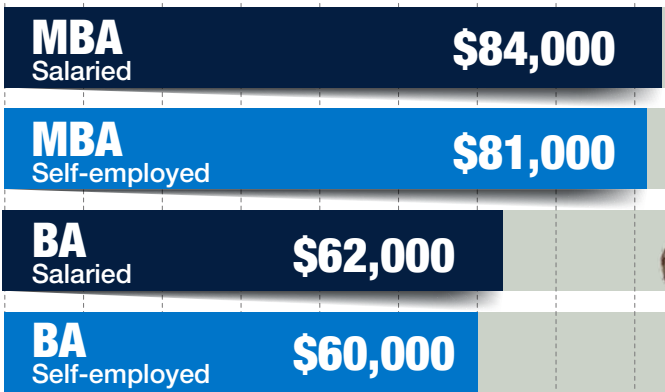

# Application Process

## Applying to Northwood

- Northwood makes it easy to apply to be a student. GMAT and GRE are waived for international students.\* No application fee required. Visit our online application page to get started: [apply.northwood.edu](http://apply.northwood.edu)

## Documents Required:

- University transcripts and diploma
- CV
- Proof of English proficiency
- Copy of passport ID page

**Other requirements include:** Face-to-face Skype interview with DeVos Graduate School Admissions, 30 minute writing sample, Transcript evaluation

## To Accept Our Offer & Begin the I-20 Process

Once you have received your admittance confirmation to the MBA program, the following is required to accept our offer:

- Send Northwood University original transcripts directly from your school.
- Pay Commitment Deposit.
- Copies of sponsor's bank statements (Minimum \$34,782 for Master's program).
- Submit proof of financial support.

Your I-20 immigration document will be shipped for you to schedule the visa interview.

## Intensive English Program

Northwood University's Intensive English Program (IEP) offers English language instruction for international students. The IEP classes help students make a successful transition to BBA and MBA programs and prepare you for university classes.

Students who do not have the required TOEFL or IELTS score may apply for the Intensive English Program. English proficiency requirements are shown below.

IELTS	6.5 overall band score (6.0 probationary admission)
EIKEN	Grade Pre-1
Cambridge English Tests	CAE or CPE (minimum score of C1)
Oxford Online Placement Test (OOPT)	80 (minimum score)
ELS	Level 112
PTE Academic	80 (minimum score)

SAT, ACT and IB English scores are not accepted for graduate admission.
