INCOME FROM EMPLOYMENT WAGES

International students are eligible to work on-campus up to 20 hours per week. Jobs are not guaranteed by the university, rather, students need to search and apply for jobs on their own. However, if a student can obtain an entry level job which pays only \$8.00 per hour, and works only ten hours per week for five of the nine first months— earnings of \$1,650 are quite possible. SNHU also allows students to participate in Curricular Practical Training internships after they have been enrolled for nine months. The amount of earnings will depend on, (a) the skills of each student, (b) their English communication ability, and (c) their individual initiative in applying for employment.

HOW AND WHEN TO PAY THE TUITION AND FEES FOR THE FIRST ACADEMIC YEAR

Tuition & Fees to the University: Tuition costs are \$3,600 per term, payable at the beginning of each of the three terms of the first academic year.

INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Spring: April 27

Master Applicants: Applicants are required to have an undergraduate degree from an accredited institution or from a recognized international university, with an accumulative GPA of 3.0. A \$33,800 Bank Statement is required. TOEFL or IELTS is required for admission. GRE/GMAT is **NOT** required
