To Accept Our Offer & Begin the I-20 Process

To accept admittance to Northwood University, we need the following:

- Send Northwood University original transcripts directly from your school.
- Pay Committment Deposit (Refer to your acceptance letter for payment amount).
- Copies of sponsor's bank statements (Minimum \$40,000 for Bachelor's program, \$34,782 for Master's program).
- Submit proof of financial support.

Your I-20 immigration document will be shipped for you to schedule the visa interview.

Intensive English Program

Northwood University's Intensive English Program (IEP) offers English language instruction for international students. Students who do not have the required TOEFL or IELTS score may apply for the Intensive English Program. English proficiency requirements are shown below.
