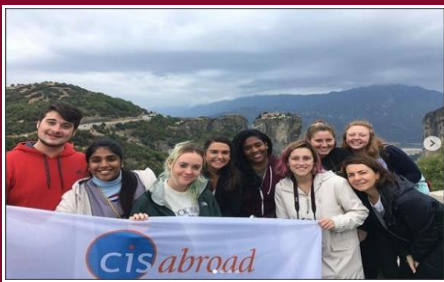

Living off Campus

Although Hellenic American College is not a residential college, the Office of Student Affairs can help students in finding reasonably priced accommodations in the city. For International Students enrolled in degree programs, it usually means getting a shared and furnished apartment around the downtown area at a cost of approximately 300 Euros per person, making it one of the cheapest accommodations around Greece for students. For shorter stays, there are arrangements with several budget and small boutique hotels that offer discounted rooms for students.

Application Requirements

Undergraduate

- ❖ Senior Secondary Degree with minimum 2.5 GPA from an accredited high school.
- ❖ Official Degree Certificate, Transcript, and certificates of all secondary school.
- ❖ Medical Certificate.
- ❖ Personal essay.
- ❖ Two Recommendation letters.

Graduate

- ❖ An undergraduate degree with minimum 2.5 GPA from an accredited college or university.
- ❖ Signed and sealed envelopes containing official transcripts.
- ❖ Medical Certificate.
- ❖ Resume and Statement of Purpose.
- ❖ Two Recommendation letters.
